

Façade Grant Scoring 2024

Historic Preservation (30 points)

- Preservation of Historic Features: Does the project preserve and enhance any historic features of the building? (10 points)
- Use of Traditional Materials: Are traditional or historically accurate materials being used in the façade improvement? (5 points)
- Plans have been approved by the Centralia Historic Preservation Commission?
 (15 points)

Aesthetic Impact (25 Points)

- Harmony with Historic Character: Does the proposed façade design align with the historical aesthetics of downtown Centralia? (10 points)
- Visual Appeal: How visually attractive is the proposed façade improvement?
 (5 points)
- Compatibility with Surroundings: Does the proposed design complement the adjacent buildings and streetscapes? (10 points)

Economic Impact (15 points)

• Business Viability: Will the façade improvement positively impact the economic viability of the business or the surrounding area? (15 points)

Critical Need (10 points)

 Addresses safety risks to the public or brings the building's facade into building code compliance. (10 points)

Project Budget and Feasibility (10 points)

- Budget Realism: Is the proposed budget realistic for the scope of the project?
 (5 points)
- Project Timeline: Is the project timeline feasible and well-planned with a viable completion schedule by **September 30, 2024** (5 points)

Sustainability and Accessibility (5 points)

• Sustainable Practices: Does the project incorporate environmentally friendly and sustainable practices? (5 points)

Please note: If the project involves entry to the building, it must meet all ADA requirements – project will not be funded unless ADA requirements are met.

Location (5 points)

• Project is within the Historic Downtown 'Main Street' service area. (5 points)

Please Note: Compliance with Centralia Municipal Code and Historic Preservation Committee regulations is **required**. Please submit your information to Hillary Hoke **one week** in advance of the Historic Committee meetings, which are held the **first Thursday of each month**.
